DESCRIPTION:

Supervisors are elected officials who serve on a five-member board that establishes and implements programs to protect and conserve soil, water, prime and unique farmland, woodland, wildlife, energy, and other resources on local, state, and private lands.

DUTIES:

- Develop policies and priorities for local conservation needs.
- Educate and inform landowners, operators, the public, and local, state, and federal legislators on conservation issues and programs.
- Hire and maintain personnel policies and procedures.
- Budget district funds and ensure all fiduciary responsibilities are met.
- Develop partnerships with federal, state, and local government, district associations, and private groups.
- Ensure the SWCD follows all state, local, and federal rules and regulations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Interest or background in natural resources or conservation.
- Communications skills

RELATIONSHIPS:

- Other elected state and local officials
- State conservation agency

BENEFITS:

- Being part of a team with a clear and unique purpose.
- Make a difference locally for future generations.
- Input into local, state, and federal conservation programs.
- Training and network opportunities.
- Stipend and expenses paid for related training and activities.


